STUDENT MILITARY LEAVE OF ABSENCE AND RE-ENROLLMENT

Policy

Military leave of absence is available for students who serve, either voluntarily or involuntarily, on active duty in the armed services of the United States, including service by a member of the National Guard or Reserve on active duty for a period of more than 30 consecutive days. Upon release from active duty, the student will be restored to the academic status attained prior to being ordered to active duty without loss of academic credits earned, scholarships or grants awarded, or tuition or other fees paid prior to the commencement of such duty. The student has the option of crediting any refund of tuition and fees to the next semester (or part of term) after the termination of the educational military leave of absence.

Re-enrollment - Process

The process for re-enrollment for veterans who have left the University on military leave of absence is intended to be streamlined requiring a minimal amount of administrative effort.

- 1. Any student who has been granted a military leave of absence is eligible for reenrollment at the University provided the following:
 - x the cumulative length of the student's absences from the University because of service on active duty does not exceed five years (which period may be extended in certain case
